Please see below an overview of the requested information for daily report. In this overview, the cumulative counts are based on confirmed COVID-19 cases; the current number of probable and suspected cases are reported separately.

Attention: Please be aware that the additional case, which we reported for Curacao on June 24th, was a misread in the lab and that the person actually tested negative for COVID-19. Consequently, there have been no new cases in the Dutch OCTs in the past week and we would like to ask you to adjust the case count for the Dutch OCTs in your administration accordingly.
