 Great to hear from you. Yes let's talk on the phone - can we make it the following Monday as (10)(2e) . I would hope RESCEU2 would include a WP aiming to promote a broad resp surveillance that would include COVID / emerging infections - building on the group that met to discuss RSV surveillance. I would also hope the disinclination to invest in surveillance across Europe will reverse and progress will be accelerated in the coming years. There is also some chance that a vaccine may become available in the lifetime of RESCEU2 which again would make this work really well timed. Then there would analyses of future data looking at effects of RSV on COVID and vice versa and if lockdowns on health care attendances from RSV and other resp viruses.

I have a new PA and it seems to be taking ages to arrange the next WP2.1 meeting but I will get him to do this once he gets back from holiday so that we can discuss this there also
