

SCHEDULE 2

**SPECIFIC AGREEMENTS TO THE
COVID-19 TESTING SERVICES BY EUROFINS**

The definitions used in this Schedule 2, will have the same meaning as provided in the Contract.

1. Target Capacity

1.1 In light of the provision of the Services Eurofins has agreed with the processing of Eligible Samples for the State;

28 th of August 2020 up to and including 6 th of September 2020	No minimum volume	
7 th of September 2020 up to and including 20 th of September 2020	5.1.1c Eligible Samples per day	
21 st September 2020 up to and including 4 th of October 2020	5.1.1c Eligible Samples per day	
From 5 th of October 2020 onwards	5.1.1c of actual capacity	

- 1.2 From **October 5th** onwards a minimum quantity of 5.1.1c of the actual capacity of the Eligible Samples to be tested by Eurofins is guaranteed by the State. For example: Calculating from the maximum capacity of 5.1.1c the guaranteed quantity is 5.1.1c per day (in words: 5.1.1c)
- 1.3 The Target Capacity can be ramped up to eventually a maximum of 5.1.1c (in 5.1.1c to be processed per day by Eurofins for the State, 5.1.1c processed in laboratories in Germany, 5.1.1c processed in laboratories in the Netherlands.
- 1.4 Indicated number of Eligible Samples sent to Eurofins can be +/- 10% [To be discussed]

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- 1.5 The number of processed Eligible Samples shall be calculated on a monthly average (calculated from the 1st to the last calendar day of the Month), If and when the calculated number of processed Eligible Samples is lower than the applicable guaranteed minimum volume (as set out in article 1.1 of this Schedule 2), Eurofins shall invoice the guaranteed minimum volume to the State.

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2. Target Turnaround Time Netherlands

The maximal Target Turnaround Time with regard to Eligible Samples which will be processed in the Netherlands is a 24 (in words: twenty-four) hour period from Time Zero to the Response Date.

KPI Service level: 95% within Target Turnaround Time Netherlands

3. Target Turnaround Time other countries

The maximal Target Turnaround Time with regard to Eligible Samples which will be processed in any country other than The Netherlands, is a 36 (in words: thirty-six) hour period from Time Zero to the Response Date;

KPI Service level: 90% within Target Turnaround Time other countries

4. Prices and Tariffs

4.1

All Services are included in the price with the understanding that the Services do not deviate from the content thereof as the Parties currently have agreed upon.

- 4.2 The Fees shall be calculated based on the average number of Eligible Samples processed per day in the respective calendar month (calculated from the 1st to the last day of the Month) by Eurofins when providing the Services as it is recorded in CoronIT.

5. Specified Services**Delivery and collection of Eligible Samples:**

- 5.1 Eurofins will provide, on request of a GGD location, Collection Materials (as defined below) to be used for the obtainment of the Eligible Samples. .

The collection materials are:

- Pre-labelled collection tube with cap filled with buffer (lysisbuffer, UTM or GLY are allowed);
- a nasopharyngeal and throat swab. With a sealbag with absorption filter;
- Swabs must be CE-marked.
- Buffer must be compatible with the diagnostic test and not dangerous during correct use by the GGD-staff.

Hereinafter jointly referred to as the "Collection Materials".

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5.2 The costs for the Collection Materials are included in the price.

5.3 Delivery of the Collection Materials to the GGD-locations will be on a weekly basis.

7. Transportation of the Eligible Samples to the Laboratories

7.1 Eurofins is responsible for transportation of the Eligible Samples from the GGD-locations to the Facilities. This will be done at least twice a day at a maximum of forty (40) GGD-locations.

7.2 Eurofins will use its best efforts to draft a pick-up schedule of the Eligible Samples which it will share with the GGD-locations.

7.3 Transportation of the Eligible Samples should be compliant to the applicable legislation (such as Dutch ADR legislation).

8. IT and data

8.1 Eurofins undertakes to implement a CoronIT connection before starting to provide Services at a Facility insofar this is necessary for the due execution of the Services.

8.2 Eurofins will provide the Test Results via CoronIT on a daily basis.

9. Organisation/Communication

9.1 Eurofins will assign a project-team with appropriate technical and logistic knowledge in order to coordinate and secure proper ramp up of the Target Capacity including securing the quality level of Test Results.

9.4 Eurofins has a team with medical microbiologists for troubleshooting and questions from the GGD-locations. regarding the analysis and quality of Test Results, the team must be available seven (7) days a week during office hours, 8-17h GMT +1.
