Thank you for your e-mail.

Yes, I am aware. I was in touch with [redacted] throughout Friday – see e-mail attached.

We have allocated [redacted] more vials from the [redacted] that the other countries does not need to the Netherlands. This makes a total 3<sup>rd</sup> shipment of [redacted] vials. [redacted] were sent last week as 1<sup>st</sup>, urgent part and have reached. The rest should come this week “asap”. The batch that Gilead meant to send out was a bit longer in the quality assurance process than they anticipated – this is what I understand from them. Gilead is aware that shipping to the Netherlands is very urgent and they usually use airfreight in these cases so delivery is assured in 24 hrs.

I will keep you and colleagues posted once I know from Gilead when and how much they will ship.
