# EU timelines

- **Proposed actions**
- October to December 2020
- Member States should ensure the capacity of vaccination services to deliver COVID-19 vaccines.
- October to December 2020
- Member States should ensure easy access to vaccines for target populations, both in terms of affordability and physical proximity.
- October onwards
- Member States should prepare for deployment of vaccines with different characteristics and storage and transport needs.
- October onwards
- Member States should ensure that Immunization Information Systems and other vaccination registries are updated and ready to process vaccination data.
- October onwards
- Member States should ensure clear communication on the benefits, risks and importance of COVID-19 vaccines.
- October to 2022
- Member States and public health authorities should prepare to undertake studies, independent of industry interests, of vaccine effectiveness and safety.

# Vaccinatie adviezen in voorbereiding, prioritering

## **Voorbeeld -> JCVI (Joint Committee Vaccination and Immunization UK)**

- 1.older adults' resident in a care home and care home workers<sup>1</sup>
- 2.all those 80 years of age and over and health and social care workers<sup>1</sup>
- 3.all those 75 years of age and over
- 4.all those 70 years of age and over
- 5.all those 65 years of age and over
- 6.high-risk adults under 65 years of age
- 7.moderate-risk adults under 65 years of age
- 8.all those 60 years of age and over
- 9.all those 55 years of age and over
- 10.all those 50 years of age and over
- 11.rest of the population (priority to be determined)

## EU commission

The Communication therefore provides examples of unranked **priority groups to be considered** by countries once COVID-19 vaccines become available, including:

- healthcare and long-term care facility workers;
- persons over 60 years of age;
- persons whose state of health makes them particularly at risk;
- essential workers;
- persons who cannot socially distance;
- more disadvantaged socio-economic groups.
