Enclosed please find the syndromic surveillance reports for epi wk 35 from Curaçao, St.Maarten & the BES islands. Curaçao shows a spike in incidence of respiratory disease as well as for undifferentiated fever. There has been an increase of local transmission of COVID-19. Perhaps this is being reflected here. Our syndromic surveillance sentinel stations are also testing for COVID-19 and they have picked up several cases the past week. Local transmission of Covid is also reported in Bonaire as well as still in St. Maarten.
