Thank you for your interest in the PIENTER Corona study.
And I'm sorry for the delay in my response.

The info on the slides which were presented by (10)(2e) end of April are preliminary.
We are in the process of analyzing more sera (total then around 3000 samples) and updating the seroprevalence data.

Unfortunately, this will take another few days and I understand that there is little time.
So, if you use the numbers given below, please indicate these are not final.

The preliminary data:

From the 2096 fingerstick samples, we found 3,6% seropositive against S1 of SARS-CoV-2.
Under 19 years of age: 1% (0.3-2,3% CI, 4/414 persons) and between 20-90 years of age this is 4.2% (3.3-5.3% CI, 71/1682 persons)
Majority of the samples were taken between march 31- April 3rd with more samples coming in up to april 13th.

For the transmission study you can contact Dr (10)(2e) (10)(2e) (10)(2e) (10)(2e). She is (10)(2e) investigating transmission within the household.
