Thank you for the new fiches we received on Saturday. Yesterday 10.2.e and I had a short chat with 10.2.e and 10.2.e to discuss how to move forward.

We had a first look at the fiches which are forward-looking and this is very welcome. As briefly mentioned yesterday to [10.2.e] and [10.2.e], more work is needed so that we can better assess the projects, including on key aspects such as tagging, DNSH self-assessment, costing and state aid. As mentioned during the technical meetings, we would like to highlight that to engage in thorough discussions on the measures we need to see consistent and comprehensive draft components following the guidance provided to Member States.

At this stage, we intend to provide feedback in writing on the new fiches received, in particular on eligibility issues, CSRs and the link to reforms, and where appropriate on DNSH. We hope to be able to send you comments on a subset of the fiches already next week, and will aim to cover all of them by mid-April.

Should outstanding questions remain after our written feedback, we can organise one or more dedicated meetings to have further discussions on specific issues/projects. We hope this proposed way forward is agreeable to you.

Please find attached the new set of fiches on various policy areas that we would like to discussing during the next meetings:

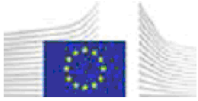
- Wednesday 7 April, 14h-17h: Component 3 (investment) and Component 5 (digital)
