Thank you for your letter and document submissions in response to issues identified by the 10.2.a

10.2.a concerning Port of Entry Violation 2019-NL-82EG-01 for 2-amino-flubendazole received on July 12, 2019. 10.2.a

10.2.a has not established a tolerance for 2-amino-flubendazole, therefore, any amount detected is violative.

10.2.a has reviewed the submitted responses from the Ministry of Agriculture and would like to request clarification. We appreciate that the Netherlands has a comprehensive animal identification and registration system that includes information on the use of veterinary drugs. However, for 10.2.a to understand this case and the implemented corrective actions, 10.2.a requests that the Ministry provides the following specific information:

- Identify the specific source and cause of the violative 2-amino-flubendazole findings;
- Describe the specific components that make up the industry's new advanced monitoring system being developed for the detection of veterinary drugs that are violative in 10.2.a
- Describe the specific details of the Ministry's comprehensive system for the identification and registration of animals for the production of meat destined for export to 10.2.a ;
- If the establishment has developed any specific corrective actions or preventive measures to address the identified source(s) and cause(s), please describe both of them and, as applicable, any verification activities conducted by the Ministry to those actions and measures are adequate to prevent recurrence of this residue finding; and

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- Identify any specific planned or implemented changes to the government inspection system resulting from the assessment of your investigation.

10.2.a values the collaboration with the Ministry and remains available to discuss any of the content of this letter and attachments by phone or electronic mail. We look forward to your reply within 30 days of receiving this letter.
