Dear 10.2.e,

How is life in 10.2.a?

10.2.a

I would like to ask for your assistance concerning an issue we have with a blocked container at the customs in 10.2.a.

The details:

On 2019-10-11 there is a container (10.1.c) loaded with boxes containing the products "frozen Pork leg, Bone in". On the documents is stated that the products are produced at EG-61, also on the Health Certificate EG-61 is stated. After control on our side, it appears that because of a human failure there are boxes loaded from EG-312 instead of EG-61. The container is now held by the customs in 10.2.a, because of the fact that the documents mention EG-61 while there are only boxes from EG-312.

In short:

- Boxes with the product "Frozen pork leg, Bone in" are loaded at 2019-10-11 at buiten reikwijdte
- Because of a human error, 10.2.a approved products of EG-312 are loaded in the container 10.1.c , instead of 10.2.a approved products of EG-61 (as mentioned at the documents). Wrong documents with this container.
- All products in this container are eligible for export to 10.2.a
- The issue is analyzed and verified with the Dutch competent authorities, the NVWA, the NVWA is willing to replace the certificate. In order to realize this replacement the NVWA needs a demand from the 10.2.a customs for a replacement of the certificate.
- Our 10.2.a customer suggests that we have found the failure and that a question for replacement through the Embassy would be needed urgently before the 10.2.a authorities start a fraud investigation..
