Thanks a lot for this, please find comments attached. I think it is good to share this with the other people who are part of the team - I added a proposal for this in a comment box in the document - and to provide a deadline for comments for this. If we consider serology, we need to include someone from IDS as well - maybe we need to do this anyway - also to help with discussions later on about sensitivity of the test.

One thing I'd like to raise is whether we need to exclude participants who came to the test street because they are household contacts of a confirmed case: it is not surprising they acquired it. Alternatively, we could have a household specific questionnaire - it would be useful to check the literature about what is known about RF for household transmission.
