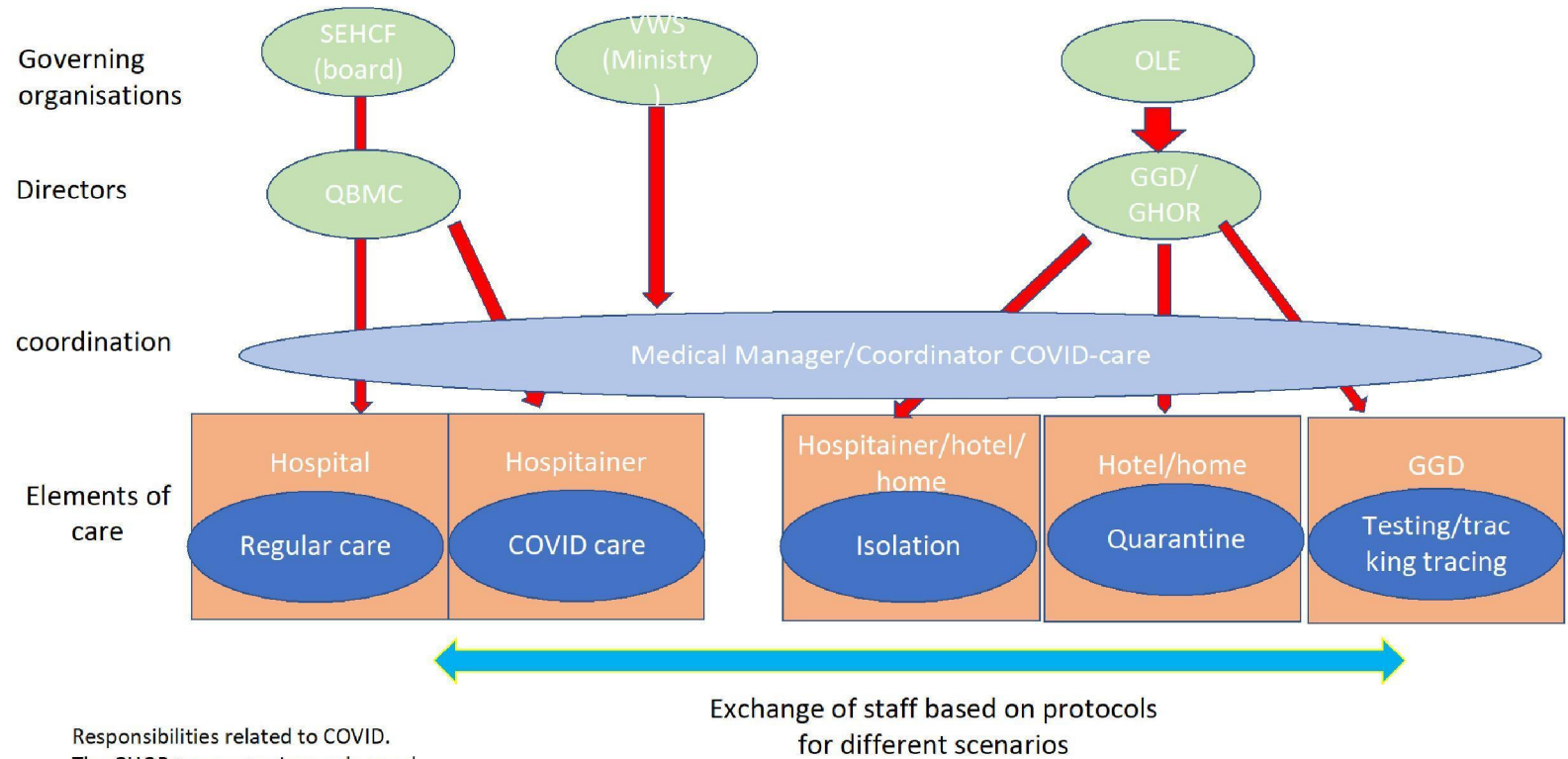


Managing structure COVID care

Responsibilities related to COVID.
The GHOR team remains unchanged
for other type of incidents/crisis

Principles

- **General Governance**
 - SEHCF is responsible for the Hospital and has a hospital director assigned for leading the business
 - VWS lease lend the hospitainer to SEHCF
 - VWS assigns a medical manager taking for leading the work on COVID Care
 - OLE is responsible for the public healthcare and has a GGD director assigned to lead the public healthcare
- **Specific Responsibilities COVID**
 - Based on the wet publieke gezondheidszorg and the veiligheidswet BES the GGD is responsible for the coordination of the healthcare during a response and can give guidance to the healthcare organisations.

Medical manager/coordinator COVID care

- **A new position is established with two main tasks.**

Responsibilities :

- Medical Manager:
 - Director of the hospitainer, responsible for the daily management of the hospitainer and the coordination with the rest of the medical care institutions.
- Coordinating COVID related CARE under the responsibility of the GGD:
 - Coordinating the five pillars relevant for COVID Care.
 - Assuring an effective medical health system during the thread of COVID-Casis
 - Coordinating with other healthcare related organisations (f.e. zvk)
 - Producing and updating protocols related to COVID Care (including in/outgoing patients, quarantine and isolation protocols)

Daily Management

- The hospital director, the Medical Manager and the GGD director meet regularly (bi- weekly) to assure the coordination of the daily care/COVID Care.
 - Protocols regarding cooperation are agreed on in this management board.
- Based on the situation/amount of work in each of the five pillars the available healthcare staff will be re-allocated to another pillar
 - From each healthcare staff member will be identified if they can be transferred to another pillar
 - They can only be transferred if they are trained for it.
