Dear colleagues,

You will find enclosed the joined ECDC/WHO Europe proposal for the collection of data on vaccine distribution and number of individuals receiving the vaccine in the European countries, including the EU/EEA as well as non EU Member States. The system aims to collect timely data on the number of vaccines received at country level and the number of individuals receiving the vaccine in an aggregated format by age group, in healthcare workers and in long term care facilities. It is also proposed to collect subnational data in order to inform on the vaccination campaign at subnational level.

While the set of data proposed may be quite comprehensive, in agreement with WHO/Europe we defined a "Minimum mandatory reporting" metadataset (See Vaccine data collection document). This minimum mandatory reporting includes weekly data on vaccine distribution to the country, data on number of individuals receiving the vaccines in the whole population (first and second doses or "unknown dose") and disaggregated by age group as well as in healthcare workers (page 2 in the reporting proposal).

#### The commission requested timely update of the data.

**While you are encouraged to update and report on a daily basis, we ask you to report at least twice a week during the first weeks in order that we to meet the commission reporting deadline, according to the following schedule:**

- For vaccines received/number of individuals receiving the vaccine Monday to Sunday of the previous week, data should be reported every Tuesday by 23:59 and updated retrospectively; updates to the transmission status should also be reported by the same deadline.
- Preliminary data for the current week should be reported every Friday by 23:59 and refer to vaccines received/ number of individuals receiving the vaccine Monday-Thursday of the current week.
- **The European Commission would like a first summary report on Monday 18 January. We would like to therefore ask you to report your first data by Friday 15 January 23:59. We will take a snapshot of the data in TESSy on Monday 18 January at 07:00. We thank you in advance for the effort provided in order to meet this short deadline.**
- We also ask you to report retrospective data for the previous weeks since the campaign started.

We joined in the email a template of the reporting which is expected.


We are fully aware that some of you may experience difficulties while using a system you may not be familiar with. Therefore the TESSy helpdesk is available for any support you may need. A reporting protocol as well as template csv files are attached to show how to report. In TESSy you will also find a manual entry page which you can use. If you have any questions please let us know. We will assess the questions received and consider whether a training session would be useful. If you need access to TESSy in order to report data, you need to contact the National Coordinator in your country who is able to provide you with the relevant rights. Again, please get in touch if you need contact information.
