Laatst had je doorgegeven dat er Nederlanders die positief getest waren voor COVID-19 op een Camping waren geweest in Agde. Ik dacht dat je het leuk zou vinden om te zien wat er uit voort is gekomen.

Zie hieronder:

We have been informed of a cluster in the city of Agde, Occitanie (South of France). This cluster is considered to be at high risk of international diffusion since a major part of the tourists come from European countries.

The situation on 16/08 is as follows:

- 38 positive cases on the naturist site of Cap d'Agde; earliest test on 3/8, most recent yesterday 15/8.
- Several affected places (hostels, camping site) within the site, affecting employees of tourist companies as well as tourists. As far as we know, only one restaurant, with 3 cases and one 'undetermined' out of 9 employees, closed completely on 12/8. Other establishments stopped their evening activities.
- Contact-tracing is carried out around each reported case, with isolation measures for the case and fourteen days of isolation for high-risk contacts
- The regional authorities have launched an awareness and screening campaign starting this week with free screening by RT-PCR.
- Several nocturnal events without respect of protective measures leading to a large number of contacts per case and difficult identification of contacts.
- A large proportion of foreign tourist from different European countries with a short length of stay (4-7 days), traveling by plane or or by their own means (caravan, car).

- The foreigners reported positively by the NFP are, a priori, holidaymakers and not employees:  
 8 from the Netherlands,  
 2 from the United Kingdom  
 1 from Austria.

In response to this report, please let us know if nationals from your country are or would be connected to this cluster and please keep us informed of new cases related to this cluster. We will report additional information on a regular basis in this thread.

Please note, that in Slovenia we have one case with connection to this cluster. This is [REDACTED] who was on vacation at the respective camp from [REDACTED]. The onset of symptoms was on 5.8.2020, when covid-19 was confirmed. Before (3.8.-5.8.) [REDACTED]

We actually have two recent cases (tested positive on 13th August) who have been in Agde for holidays. EWRS team Luxembourg

At the weekend we were notified of three cases of COVID-19 in a family group that returned from Toulouse on 10th August. A family of five – three positive to date. The father was symptomatic since August 4th, and mother since 10th August (both flew with symptoms). Daughter is asymptomatic. They flew on the 25th July from Dublin to Carcosonne. Train to Cap D'agde Stayed the whole holiday in [REDACTED] in Cap D'agde Train on 10th Aug to Toulouse and then a taxi to the airport. Flew Toulouse to Ireland (contact tracing is being done on close contacts on flight). EWRS contact point Ireland

in Italy, the Regional Health Service in [REDACTED] identified a case possibly connected to this cluster. An Italian tourist, [REDACTED] stayed at the naturist site of Cap d'Agde on August 4. Onset of symptoms was on 08/08/2020, the case was visited at [REDACTED] on 10/08/2020, RT-PCR positive on 11/08/2020.

Currently isolated, not hospitalized. They have not identified secondary cases so far. EWRS team Italy
