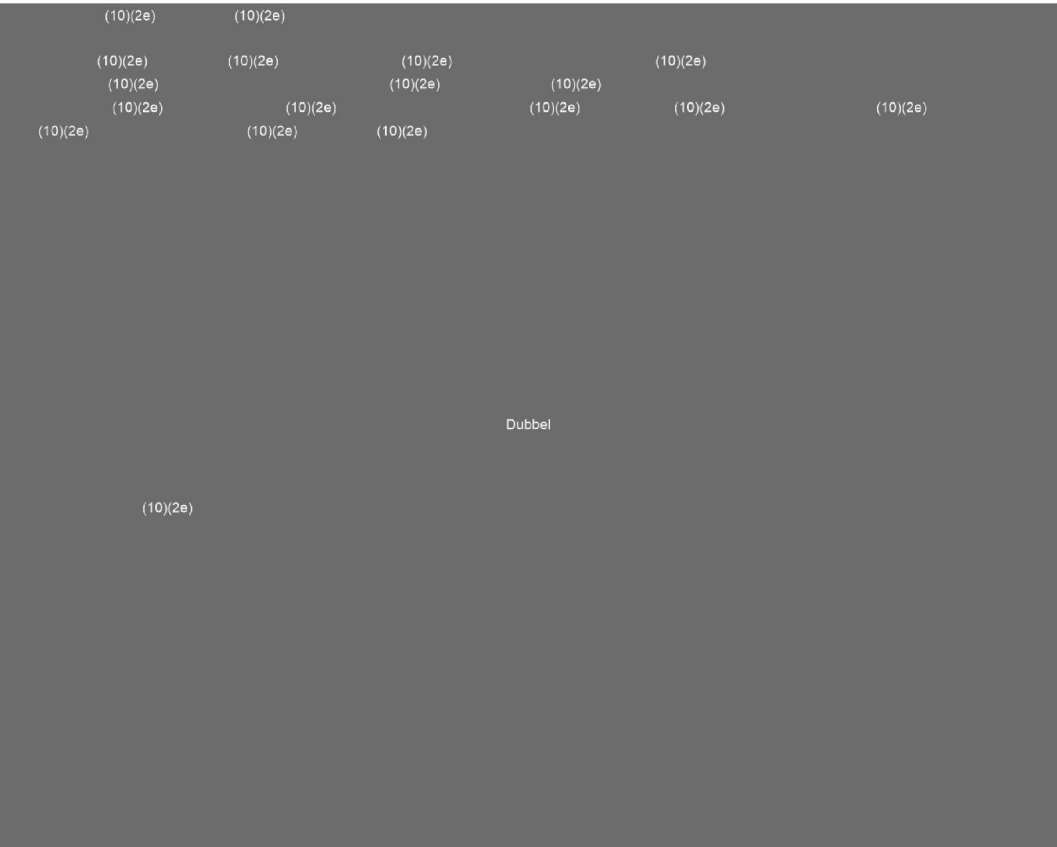
Concerning attempts to culture SARS-CoV-2 from water, here is what was published so far:
