Dear (10)(2e) we very much support the initiative to do a thorough meta-analysis of the SARS-CoV-2 secondary attack rate. However, we have only published limited preliminary data (in a Dutch language journal) and are still in the process of analysing the full data set of our 'FFX' / household study, including individual timelines. We are therefore not yet able to provide the requested data.
