Country education responses to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic

Since the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Directorate for Education and Skills has made efforts to *document how member countries and partners have ensured education continuity* through a series of papers, policy briefs, continuity stories, webinars and partnerships and developed a page bringing together these resources to offer a central place where international lessons for education could be easily accessible for members and partners. Some member countries have expressed their appreciation and suggested that the Secretariat also post country official reports documenting how learning and teaching occurred during the pandemic as well as country guidance for reopening schools. This would allow countries to find information about what others are doing. We have added the first reports we have received from the Czech Republic, Latvia, and Sweden ([link](#)) and will be happy to do the same with further reports and guidance, should countries be interested in sharing them with the international community. Those reports would ideally be in English or French – but they can be in other languages.
