Subject: Invitation to participate as a local investigator in a multicenter national clinical study focusing on the nutritional status of hospitalized patients with COVID-19.

Dear colleague,

On behalf the investigation team of the CHUV at the University of Lausanne, we kindly invite you to participate as a local investigator in a multicenter nation clinical research project "INCOVO study: Impact of Nutritional Status on COVID-19 infection Outcomes". A short synopsis of the study is attached to this letter for your confidential information.

At present, risk factors for severe pneumonia associated with SARS Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) are still under investigation. Although malnutrition is a recognized risk factor for compromised outcomes in patients with pulmonary infections, data about the nutritional status of COVID-19 infected patients and associated outcomes are scarce. Therefore, the aim of this study is to determine the relationship between nutritional status as a potential predictor of severe forms of COVID-19 infection/pneumonia and associated outcomes.

Given the recent request for application announcement by the Swiss National Foundation for Science (SNFS) to support studies on COVID-19, this project could be the subject of a national grant application.

As a recognized expert the field of clinical nutrition, we would be delighted to collaborate with you and your colleagues as a project partner and site investigator. It is our conviction that a collaborative approach would strongly enhance the value and impact of this study, and provide an unique opportunity to address this important question.
