B. Situation in border region

BE, NL, NRW and LS report that the situation at the borders is quiet.

RP informs that since Luxembourg has been declared a new risk area, the rules on quarantine demand that a test not older than 48h hours has to be presented by Luxembourgers to avoid quarantine. Only cross-border workers are excepted. This results in a situation at the border that is not easy. The test centers in LUX are overcrowded as many people want to take such tests prior to holidays.
