Dear all,

The letter was quite long, so we are also discovering the possibilities to install an parallel and intern website to increase the traceability and usability of the summaries. We hope that the positive reactions and progress on the lay out are a motivation for everyone to keep up the good work and prepare for newsletter 2.

As mentioned during the journal club, we aim to send this second newsletter coming Wednesday 27th of May. This means that **on Tuesday 26 May at 1PM, we would like to receive your contributions** (please send it to literatuur-COVID (10)(2e)@rivm.nl).

There are several possibilities that may apply to you:

- A. You did not yet send in a summary, because you did not make it last week. In this case, please send your first summary and key messages.
- B. You provided a summary last time. In this case, you can either describe any changes or additions based on the new literature (if there are any), or choose a new angle or subtheme to discuss it more thoroughly. For example, we had contact with (10)(2e) that she and (10)(2e). They provided a general summary of their cohorts on pregnancies last week, but now dive deeper into one of the subthemes such as COVID and delivery, or COVID and the neonate, or COVID during pregnancy. In this way you have more space to elaborate on the findings and explain its implications.

Please, answer to this e-mail what you plan to send in for next week. In this case, we know what we can expect.

Then, I would like to make a final note on the format. We provided a format (I attached it again), which defines the letter type, Font Size, italics / bold etc. Please use this format, and send in a piece of work that can be copy-pasted in the newsletter. Also, please double check your language and readability beforehand. Of course we are doing a round of final editing, but that would then be a lot easier and less time-consuming.

That was that for now. Since, there is no journal club tomorrow, we are just looking forward to your e-mails and contributions and hope to see you next week face-to-face in the journal club.
