Subject: IANPHI's COVID-19 Lessons Learned Initiative: request for comments on list of issues and expressions of interest for a working group

Dear EB members, Chairs and Vice Chairs of regional networks,

Following the discussions in the last two EB meetings (30 June and 25 August), please find attached for your comments a list of areas that the Secretariat has prepared for conducting the COVID-19 lessons learned initiative.

In short, the aim of this initiative is to advocate for strong NPHIs by documenting how institutes have and are responding to the COVID-19 pandemic and identifying lessons learned for the short and medium term for IANPHI members.

This set of questions has been organised by 5 main areas and are based on a number of bilateral conversations initially held by the Secretariat, information gathered during the webinars and discussions held in IANPHI meetings regarding the role, position, independence of NPHIs. We also reviewed WHO and ECDC material for conducting COVID-19 in-action reviews.

We would welcome by Monday 14 September your comments on the scope of the questions for this collective initiative and on particular areas that should be emphasised.

Moreover, as proposed by 5.1.2e in the last EB meeting, we would like to mobilise a working group to support this COVID-19 lessons learned initiative:

- **Firstly, we would like regional chairs or vice chairs to tell the Secretariat if they (or a designated representative in their institute) would be willing to join the working group, or if they would like to nominate another member of their regional network.** The regional network representatives will be responsible, with the Secretariat's support, for organising regional-level meetings to discuss priority areas of the questions identified. The conclusions of these discussions, along with any written responses to the questions from members, will be used to support the drafting of the report.

- **Secondly, we would appreciate a small number of willing EB members (or a designated representative in their institute) to come forward to also join the working group.** The EB members would be responsible for advising on one or a few of the 5 categories of questions identified and also providing their own experiences of lessons learned.

Please express your interest in joining the working group by responding to the Secretariat by Monday 14 September. Further details on organising regional-level meetings will then follow.

The working group will also support the organisation of a session during the virtual annual meeting on the COVID-19 lessons learned initiative with the aim of discussing the initial conclusions from the regional-level meetings. Following this, the lessons learned report will be drafted with an expected publication date of March 2021.
