You are invited to an all stakeholder informal consultation on implementation of decision WHA72(13) *Public health implications of implementation of the Nagoya Protocol* and an update on the PIP Framework vis-à-vis the Nagoya Protocol on **Friday, 20 November 2020 from 13:00-14:30 (CET)**. The meeting will be held virtually and interpretation in the six official languages will be provided.

The Secretariat will update Member States and stakeholders on its implementation of WHA72(13), provide an overview of the relevant report that the Executive Board will consider at its 148th session (18-26 January 2021), and engage in discussion regarding work undertaken by the WHO Office of the Legal Counsel and the PIP Framework Secretariat relevant to the Nagoya Protocol and pathogen sharing.
